COURTENEY COX AND DAVID ARQUETTE HAD HOPED TO HAVE AN African-safari honeymoon, but work commitments got in the way. The *Friends* star and the *Scream* actor did squeeze in some quality time, though. After their wedding, held at San Francisco's Grace Cathedral

on June 12 (three days before Cox's 35th birthday), Arquette, 27, and Cox stole away to the exclusive Cap Juluca resort on the island of Anguilla in the British West Indies. Then they kicked back for a few days in Florida, talking to the animals at Busch Gardens in Tampa

and riding the merry-go-round at Universal Studios in Orlando.

But who needs a merry-go-round when your wedding is enough to make anyone's head spin? Though the couple tried to keep the time and location a secret, paparazzi got wind of the event. So Cox, Arquette and their 200-plus guests had to enter the cathedral through a nearby underground garage marked with a FULL sign. (It wasn't.) Cox's family minister from Alabama, the Rev. Douglas Carpenter, performed a traditional Episcopalian ceremony, but at the end, Arquette stomped on a glass in the Jewish tradition, to honor his mother, Mardi, who was Jewish and died of breast cancer in 1997. Cox wore a Valentino silk-crepe gown, and Arquette wore a Valentino morning coat.

To get to the reception unnoticed, the couple sent out a decoy car — a vintage red Chevrolet Bel Air limo marked JUST MARRIED on the back — but in fact left some time later in a white stretch limo. Arquette then blew

his own cover when he popped out of the sunroof to toss red roses to fans.

The reception was held at Bimbo's 365, a '30s-style speakeasy, where family (including Arquette's sisters, Rosanna and Patricia, with husband Nicolas Cage) and Friends (Matt LeBlanc and his fiancée, Melissa McKnight, Matthew Perry, David Schwimmer, Lisa Kudrow and her husband, Michel Stern; and Jennifer Aniston and her boyfriend, Brad Pitt) danced, ate, and drank bottles and bottles of Dom Perignon.

The couple had actually had some practice at getting married. They tie the knot in their upcoming film, a comedy called *The Shrink Is In*, continuing an on-set romance that began when they shot *Scream II* in 1997. (They are currently filming the third installment in the slasher series.)

The Rev. Carpenter thought the couple seemed well prepared and deeply committed. "Hollywood has a reputation for not taking marriage seriously," he said. "But these two are taking it seriously." **TOM CONROY**
