Problem: Streaky makeup

"My foundation never stays put," says *Friends*' star Courtney. "Sweat makes it streak and change colors, especially under my eyes—not good if you're trying for a flawless complexion!"

Solution: "My motto with Courtney is never overdo," says Sanchez. "Heavy foundation, especially in the heat, can look and feel like a mask." If you have great skin like Courtney's, think sheer: try light foundations (Estée Lauder's Enlighten with built-in sunscreen feels like you're wearing nothing at all) and translucent powder (Clinique's Stay-Matte Sheer Pressed Powder) applied lightly with a sponge to "seal" makeup. For oily skin, use a foundation that absorbs oil (Ultima II's Wonderwear is fadeproof, creaseproof and guaranteed to last up to 18 hours).

The reason that makeup streaks, says Masterson, is that in the summer, our faces secrete more oil and the oil buildup turns makeup orangey. "I recommend carrying oil-blotting tissues in your purse," she says (Papier Poudre at The Body Shop comes in a pocket-size pack).
